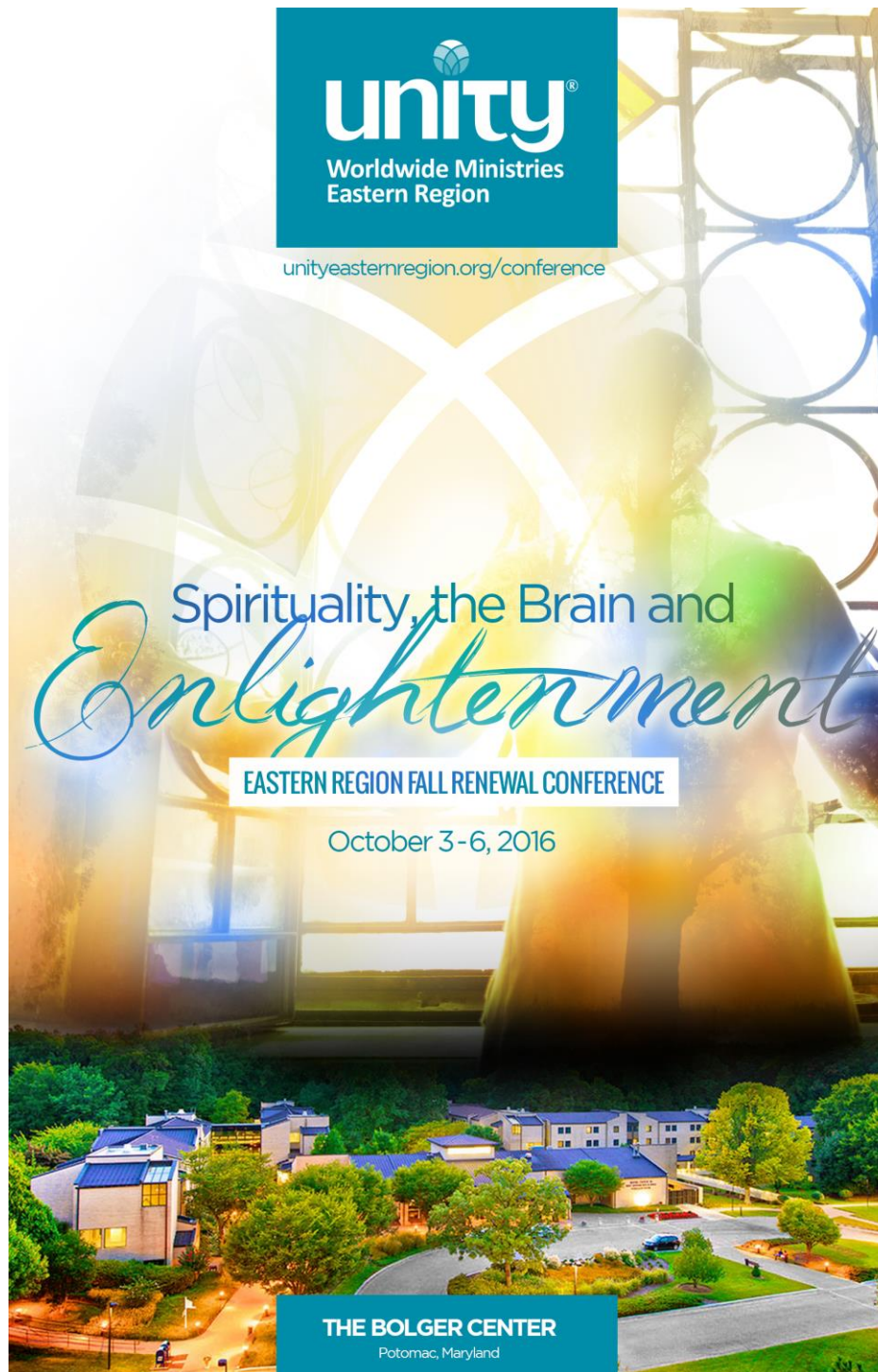

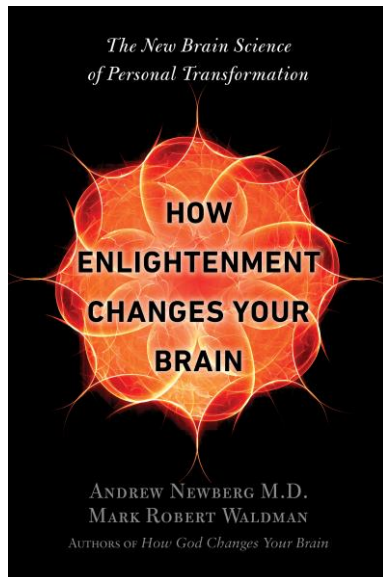

Megon is best known for her work as an inaugural member of the folk group The Four Bitchin' Babes, which allowed her wit and folk sensibilities to comment on the ups and downs of everyday life. To date, Megon has 13 solo albums to her credit, and is best known for her song "Amazing Things." Megon has collaborated with many other new thought musicians such as Daniel Nahmod, Jana Stanfield and more. She classifies her music as folk/cabaret, citing her love of theater and jazz as the reason for the unusual mix. Megon lives in Wilmette, IL., and is currently the Music Director of Unity Northwest in DesPlaines IL.
